



## **10 journalists killed and 1 missing in 2020**

**Killed: 4 in Mexico, 1 in Paraguay, 1 in Guatemala, 1 in Brazil, 2 in Honduras, 1 in Barbados**

**Missing: 1 in Peru**

**Germán Vallecillo Jr.**, journalist for Canal 45, La Ceiba, Honduras. Murdered on July 1, 2020.

**Jorge Posas**, cameraman for Canal 45, La Ceiba. Murdered on July 1, 2020.

**Christoff Griffith**, photojournalist for The Nation newspaper, Bridgetown, Barbados. Murdered on June 22, 2020.

**Jorge Armenta**, director of the Medios Obson group, Ciudad Obregón, Sonora, Mexico. Murdered on May 16, 2020.

**Leonardo Pinheiro**, owner of the A Voz Araruamense Facebook page and contributor to the Fala Araruama page, Rio de Janeiro, Brazil. Murdered on May 13, 2020.

**María Elena Ferral**, correspondent for the Diario de Xalapa of the Mexican Editorial Organization (OEM) and director of the digital newspaper Quinto Poder, Papantla, Veracruz, Mexico. Murdered on March 30, 2020.

**Bryan Leonel Guerra**, news anchor for the TL-COM Chiquimula cable system and vice president of the Chiquimula Social Communicators Network, Chiquimula, Guatemala. Murdered on February 27, 2020.

**Lourenço “Leo” Veras**, director and owner of the Porã News portal, Ponta Porã, Brazil. Brazilian journalist murdered in the border city of Pedro Juan Caballero in Paraguay on February 12, 2020.

**Daysi Mina Huamán**, journalist for the Cable VRAEM channel, Ayacucho, Peru. Missing since January 26, 2020.

**Fidel Ávila Gómez**, broadcaster and manager of the KeBuena Huetamo radio, Huetamo, Michoacán, México. Missing since November 29, 2019, found dead on January 7, 2020.

**Álvaro Ruiz**, announcer and manager of Radio Pichucalco 102.1 FM station, Chiapas, Mexico, found dead on January 5, 2020.
