PRESS FREEDOM GRAND PRIZE

In Memoriam to 13 Mexican journalists murdered this year: Sheila Johana García Olivera, Yessenia Mollinedo Falconi, Luis Enrique Ramírez, Armando Linares, Juan Carlos Muñiz, Jorge Camero, Heber López Vásquez, Roberto Toledo, Lourdes Maldonado, Margarito Martínez, José Luis Gamboa, Alfredo Cardoso Echeverría y Fredy López Arévalo.

CARTOON: (Sponsored by El Comercio, Lima, Peru)

Award: "Ordenan detener a Sergio Ramírez" (They ordered the arrest of Sergio Ramírez,) Ignacio Villamil, *El Tiempo*, Colombia, for illustrating, with sharpness and minimum resources the totalitarian drift of Daniel Ortega's regime against freedom of expression.

Honorable Mention: "¡Esperando las olas! (las dos pandemias)" (Waiting for the waves, the two pandemics), Lewis Alexander Rodríguez Duarte, *Corporación La Prensa*, Panama.

Honorable Mention: "Fracaso económico de AMLO," (AMLO's economic failure) Gilberto Bobadilla de Anda, Eje Central, Mexico.

HUMAN RIGHTS AND COMMUNITY SERVICE: (Sponsored by Debate Media, Culiacán, Sinaloa, México)

Award: "El reto tras la masacre" (The challenge after the massacre,) Colectivo, Divergentes, Nicaragua. For presenting, through 12 reports based on rigorous journalism and great use of audiovisual resources, multiple evaluations of the repression by Daniel Ortega's regime on citizen protests, in particular, the massacre of April 2018.

Honorable Mention: "Defensoras" (Advocates), Colectivo: *Mongabay Latam* (Peru and Mexico) / *Barra Espaciadora* (Ecuador) / *Rutas del Conflicto* (Colombia) / *RunRun* (Venezuela).

Award: "Las Heridas de Sendero Luminoso: la matanza de Lucanamarca" (The Wounds of the Shining Path: The Lucanamarca Massacre), Ernesto Benavides, *Agence France Presse*, Peru. For revealing, through images of extraordinary strength and human content, the impact of the murders of the Shining Path guerrilla group in Ayacucho, Peru, on the memory of its survivors.

Honorable Mention: "Amanecer en el Río Bravo. La tribu de haitianos" (Sunrise on the Rio Bravo. The Haitian tribe), Angel Omar Saucedo García, *Vanguardia*, Mexico.

Honorable Mention: "El Desierto de Atacama: vertedero clandestino de ropa usada" (The Atacama Desert: clandestine dump of used clothes), by Martin Bernetti Vera, of *Agence France Presse*, Chile.

INFOGRAPHY (Sponsored by Clarín, Buenos Aires, Argentina)

Award: "Telescopio Espacial James Web. Una nueva era de exploración" (James Web Space Telescope. A new era of exploration), Colectivo, *El Tiempo*, Colombia. For highlighting the importance of the James Web Space Telescope for space research through attractive images, simple graphics, and exciting data.

Honorable Mention: "Plaza de Mayo en llamas" (Plaza de Mayo in flames), Colectivo, *La Nación*, Argentina.

For addressing a complex and primarily ignored reality, the fate of workers' pensions in several Latin American countries. Honorable Mention: "Salud, dinero y corrupción" (Health, money and corruption), Colectivo, *PODER Latam*, Mexico.

Honorable Mention: ¿Qué tan verde es Montevideo? (How green is Montevideo) Colectivo, *El País*, Uruguay.

Award: "Pandora Papers," Investigation Partnership of the International Consortium of Investigative Journalists, and more than 40 media partners from Latin America, the Caribbean, North America, and Spain. For the unveiling, through a remarkable journalistic narrative, impressive data analysis, and engaging presentation - the result of a two-year investigation - the scourge of corruption, money laundering, and tax evasion in Latin America and beyond.

ENVIRONMENTAL JOURNALISM "ROBERTO EISENMANN JR."

Award: "Ríos muertos. Cicatrices de la minería en el sur de Perú" (Dead Rivers. Scars of mining in southern Peru), *Colectivo, Seminario en la Mira, Diario Viral, Convoca* and *Connectas*, Peru and Colombia. For denouncing, through rigorous journalistic research and a profusion of images, the environmental depredation resulting from mining exploitation by the Aruntani group, manifested in the contamination of springs and rivers, damage to livestock and aquatic species, loss of crops, and damage to human health, among other effects.

Honorable Mention: "Incendios en Venezuela", (Fires in Venezuela), Helena Carpio, *Prodavinci*, Venezuela.

HEALTH JOURNALISM (Sponsored by Robert Stempel College of Public Health & Social Work, Florida International University, Miami, Florida)

Award: "Cuidados paliativos: a medicina que alivia a dor", (Palliative care: the medicine that soothes the pain), *Colectivo, CNN Brazil*. For presenting, with rigor and delicacy - in the TV program *Sinais Vitais* - a little-covered topic of great human interest: medical care for patients with severe or terminal illnesses.

Honorable Mention: "El otro Perú" (The other Peru,) *Colectivo, Salud con Lupa*, Peru.
